

Executive Committee Members 2025

This document is submitted to the Plenary for decision.

The Executive Committee members are a representative subset from the membership of GEO Caucuses. The Executive Committee consist of 16 GEO Members based on the following geographic distribution: Africa (3), Americas (3), Asia and Oceania (4), CIS (2) and Europe (4).

Executive Committee Members, including those Members serving as Co-Chairs, are nominated through regional caucuses. Based on the conclusions of the regional caucuses and further consultations as necessary, the Director presents a slate of nominees, including those nominated to serve as Co-Chairs, to the Plenary for its approval. Upon approval, Executive Committee members will serve a term of up to two years.

For 2025, the following countries' 2-year term is due to expire:

Amendments to the Rules of Procedure

The Rules of Procedure Task Force, established under the authority of the Executive Committee, has proposed amendments to the GEO Rules of Procedure that would affect the number of seats allocated to the Americas and Africa caucuses. These recommended changes are outlined in document GEO-20-5.2, which is submitted to the GEO-20 Plenary for decision.

If adopted, the changes would take effect following the Plenary, and additional Executive Committee members from the affected caucuses would then be nominated accordingly, following the GEO-20 Plenary.
